Dear Fellow Cove Lakefront Home Owner,

Well the cool weather is back. Actually this is the coldest I've ever seen this area in the last 25 years. And with the cold weather may come some fish kills due to the low lake temperature.

I have renewed the 1 year agreement the Cove Lakefront Home Owners Association has with Aquatic Systems, Inc. And once again I am asking **ALL** Cove Lakefront Home Owners to contribute their annual maintenance fee so that we can continue to use the monthly services of Aquatic Systems, Inc. to maintain the lake by keeping the weeds and algae under control.

I **REALLY** need more folks to contribute **EVERY** year to continue having the lake professionally maintained.

The annual maintenance fee we ask of each home living on the lake is \$100 for ongoing treatments to the Cove Lake.

Also, it is recommended that, if you are able, you remove any dead algae or other debris in the lake from the shoreline behind your house. This removal keeps a higher oxygen level in the lake which is better for the fish and other wildlife in the lake. The easiest way I have found to do this is to just rake it up onto your lawn and let it dry for a day or 2 (or 3 or 4). This makes it lighter and easier to handle.
